

Prince Edward medical email terms of use

1. I wish to use email as one of the ways in which to receive communications from healthcare providers/staff associated with Prince Edward Medical (PEM) and book non-urgent appointments at PEM.
2. I understand the risks associated with communication by email between PEM healthcare providers/staff and me, and I consent to the conditions and responsibilities outlined in the PEM email communication information notice, also contained on this tablet.
3. I will comply with any further instructions that the PEM healthcare providers/staff may impose to communicate with patients/substitute decision makers by email in the future.
4. I acknowledge the rights of the PEM healthcare providers/staff to, upon the provision of written notice, withdraw the option of communicating by email.
5. I hereby waive, release, and discharge from any and all liability, PEM, its employees, and all physicians connected in any way with me as a patient, for any complications that may arise from the use of email.
6. I indemnify and hold harmless the entities or persons noted above from any and all liabilities or claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of my decision.
7. I agree to abide by the terms of this agreement and consent.
8. Any questions I may have had were answered to my satisfaction.
